9	Church Hall Redevelopment	
9.1	Phil summarised the main plans for the entire refurbishment of the Church Hall. The primary aim is engagement with the local community, so that the hall is more usable. Both halls are to become independent with an extension of the Benjamin Carter Hall to provide toilet facilities and a small kitchen. In the main hall the present Womens' toilets will provide disabled and unisex facilities and the present Gents' will become a storage area.	SB TO SHARE PLANS ONLINE
	The stage will be retained, with storage beneath. A new cupboard will be provided for the stacking chairs. The kitchen will be extended and improved, and there will be a new power link to the village green. Disabled access at front and rear will be improved.	
	The front entrance area will be opened up to provide more light. The false ceiling will be removed and the original ceiling restored. Windows will be replaced with more modern ones whilst retaining the style of the original, and keeping to Conservation rules. The heating system will be changed.	
	Financially, an insurance claim for the damaged organ will provide the starting point for these changes, and eventually the car park will be considered, with a range of quotes already sought. More research is needed as to exactly what is required. The planning, survey and start up costs are now covered.
